Code of Conduct

- **BE HONEST.**
- **TELL THE TRUTH.**
- **TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR OWN ACTIONS
AND WORDS.**
- **TREAT OTHERS WITH CARE AND RESPECT.**
This includes:
 - Looking out for the safety and welfare of each person and of yourself.
 - Never making rude or hurtful remarks.
 - Taking responsibility for safe play without physical roughness such as hitting, kicking and pushing.
- **TREAT THE SCHOOL BUILDING AND GROUNDS WITH CARE.**

Students who are thoughtful and conduct themselves according to these ideas will protect their privileges and their rights as members of the Moultonborough School Community.
